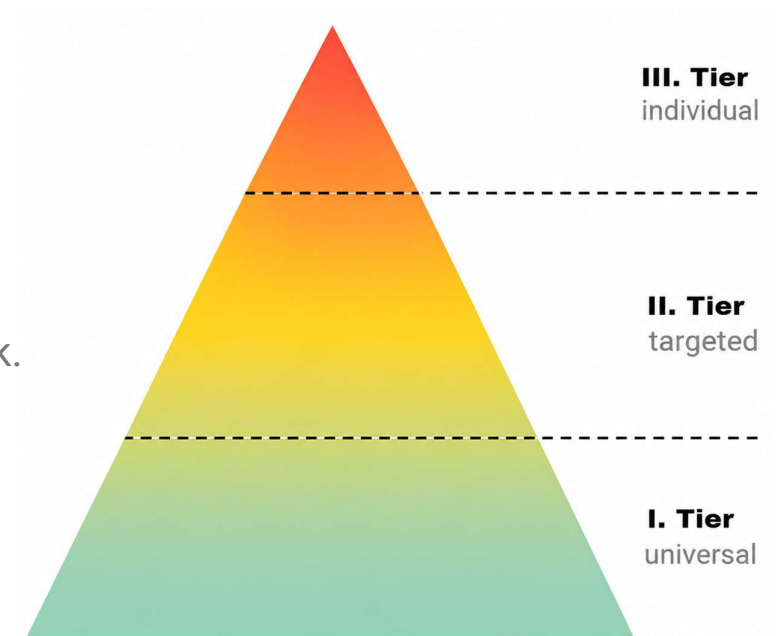

Case management and multisectoral support of children at risk.

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Advocacy

- » Roof organization for **support of wellbeing in education.**
- » Cooperation **with Ministries on strategies and legislation.**
- » Cooperation on **curriculum revision.**
- » Cooperation on Teacher Competences Framework for **faculties of education.**
- » Cooperation with **regional authorities.**
- » Localization of **evidence-informed** frameworks and programs.
- » **Training** of trainers.
- » **Long-term support** of schools.
- » **Public awareness** enhancement.



PBIS development

» 2020-23 Pilot

- Tier I in **3 primary/lower-secondary** schools with 169 trained teachers
- Development and launch of a two-day course with year-long coaching support
- **Translation and adaptation** of 4 key materials and **4 international conferences**

» 2026- Scaling

- Adaptation of PBIS for **upper-secondary schools**
- Development and pilot of **Tier II** support
- Comprehensive **evaluation**.

» 2024-25 Capacity building

- **30 PBIS coaches** with regional coverage supervised regularly by SOFA
- Implementation with coaching in **36 primary/lower-secondary schools**, 10 virtual school networking meetings per year.
- Transfer of developed approaches and materials into **pre-service teacher education**.
- Comprehensive **evaluation in 2 primary/lower-secondary schools**.

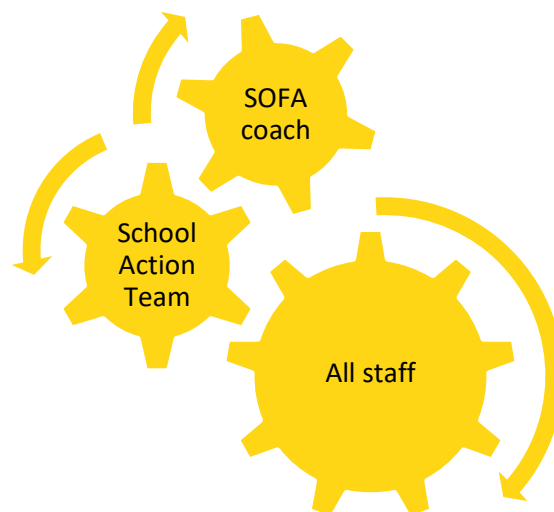

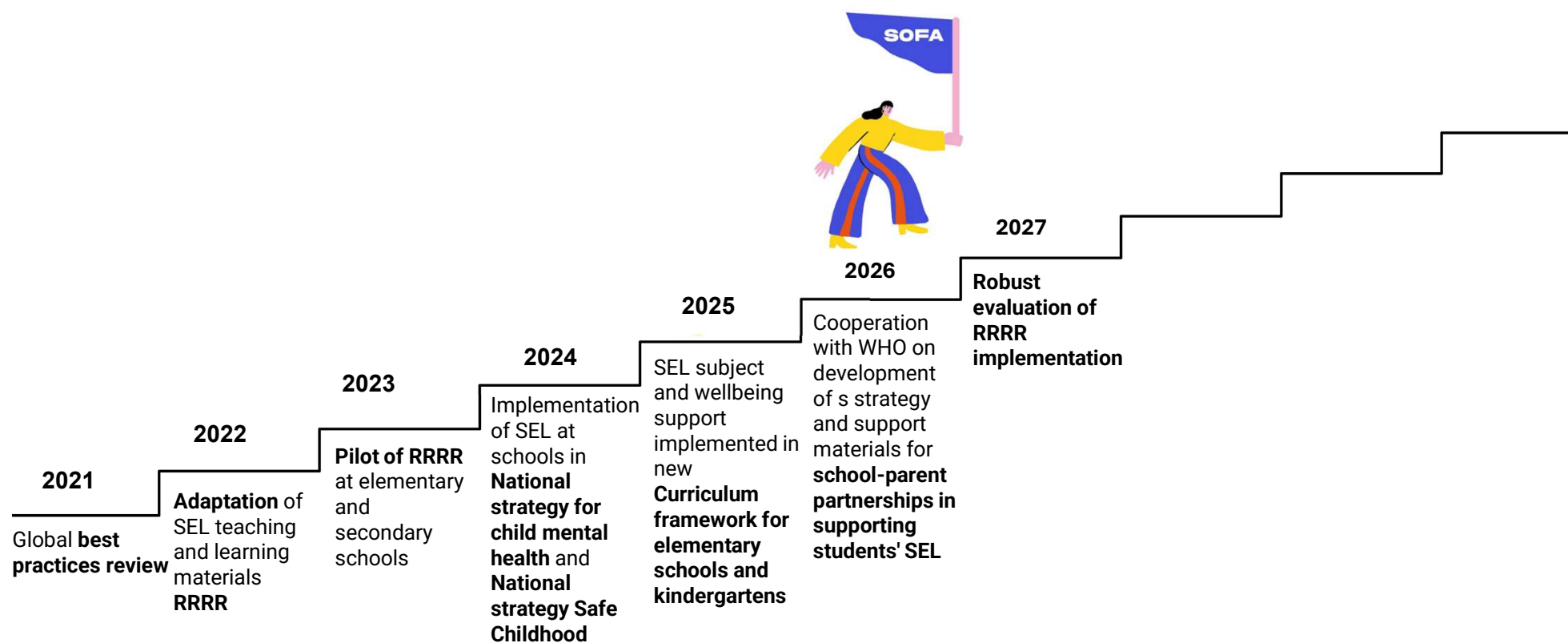

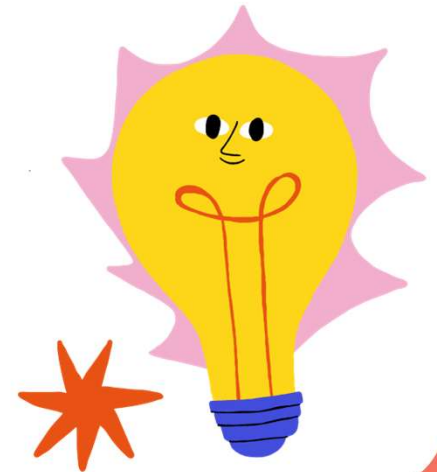
